Thank you for applying for CSULB University Housing for the 2022-2023 academic year. Unfortunately, due to the high demand for housing and limited available spaces, we are unable to provide you a confirmed space at this time. You have, however, been placed on the Paid Waitlist.

The following options are available to you:

Option One: Remain on the Waitlist

We anticipate that more spaces will become available in the coming weeks. We will contact you by email, if you are being removed from the Paid Waitlist to be offered a space. If you do not accept the space offered, you will forfeit your application and your service fee payment.

Option Two: Cancel Your Application

If you choose to cancel your application, please log on to the Housing Portal and follow the cancellation procedures. Your name will be removed from the Paid Waitlist and your service fee will be refunded.

At this time, we cannot guarantee space in a specific Residential Village or Hall. You can find more information about the Cancellation Policy at

Although you are on the waitlist, in order to live in housing you must have one of the approved Covid Vaccinations. You will need to have proof of having the first shot submitted to the SHS Patient Portal by June 15th. You should be able to start submitting necessary documentation through the Patient Portal, mid May since it is currently being updated to accept Covid vaccine documentation. If you feel you qualify for medical exemption, please contact our office and we can direct you to the correct resource.

Please note that there are several vaccinations that are required to be submitted before move-in. The Covid-19 vaccination needs to take precedence to move your application to fully confirmed. All vaccination requirements should be met before move-in this August.
